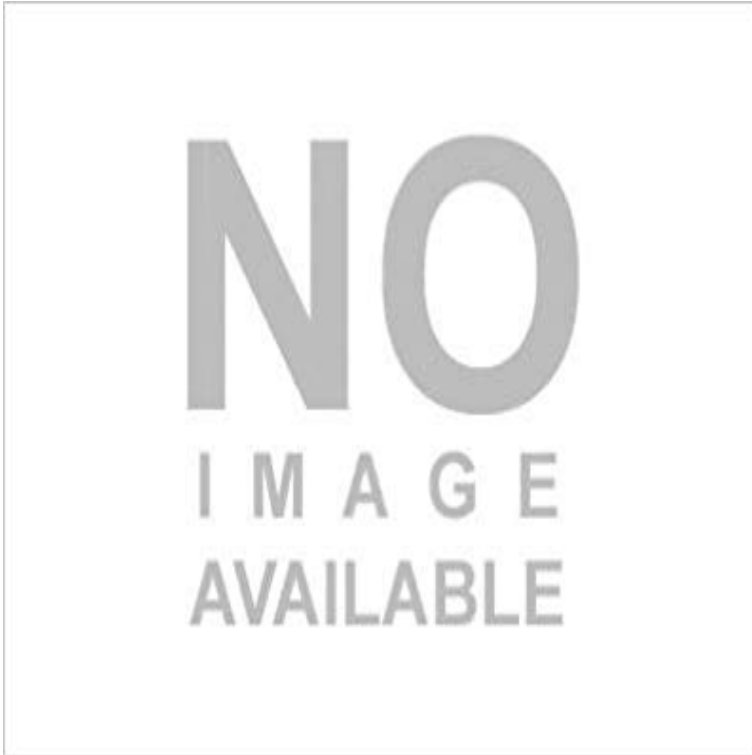


Robinson Crusoe
