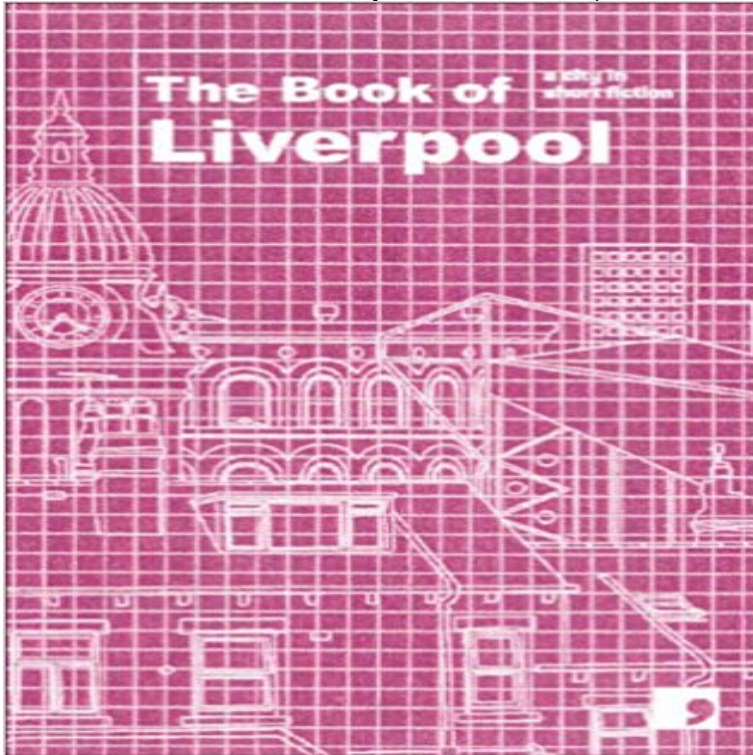


## The Book of Liverpool: A City in Short Fiction (Reading the City)
