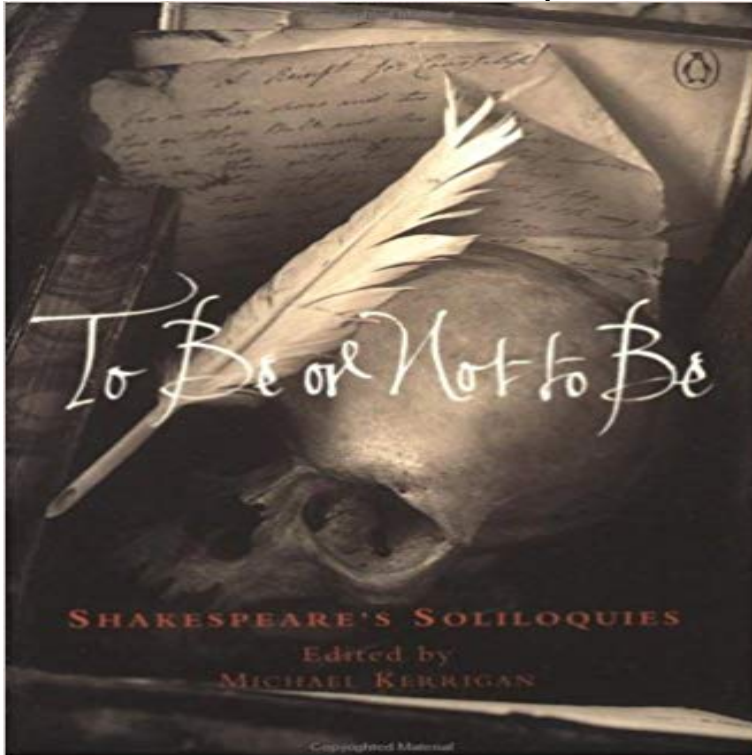


To Be or Not to Be: Shakespeares Soliloquies
